# Are you interested in attending a Young Parenthood Programme run by FAMILY LIVES?

The programme looks at the change from being a young person to being a young parent. It's not a parenting skills programme; it explores the impact that being a young parent has on your personal development.

It's over 8 weeks in a group of young parents – each session is 2 hours, with around **2 hours individual preparation** time outside of the sessions if you want to go for a qualification, which is optional. It will be run in September and is likely to be held in our office in Hatfield. Unfortunately we aren't able to offer a crèche.
