FREE SCHOOL MEAL STATUS

In addition to school funding received from Hertfordshire County Council/ the Education Funding Agency, Fairlands Primary School is able to claim a £1,300 grant from Government each year called the Pupil Premium for children whose parents or carers receive any of the benefits below:

- Income Support
- Income Based Jobseeker's Allowance
- · Pension Credit (Guarantee Credit element)
- (Income Related) Employment Support Allowance
- Child Tax Credit with income below £16,190 and not in receipt of Working
