RE: Forest School Experience

You may remember in Reception last year there was a mix up with the coach company on our trip to the Natural History Museum in Tring. This resulted in us not having to pay for the coaches when the trip was rearranged.

As a result of this we have arranged for the children to have a Forest School Experience on the school grounds **free of charge.** A company will be coming in to provide each class with a morning exploring the outdoors along the theme of hedgehogs. - A change of clothes
