If your child was born between 1st September 2011 and 31st August 2012 please apply now for a primary place for the school year 2016-17.

The quickest and easiest way to apply is on-line at <u>www.hertsdirect/admissions</u> - **Application deadline 15th January 2016.** Parents who do not have the facility to apply on-line are welcome to come to the office and use a computer. If you would like help with your application, please contact the office first to arrange a convenient time to come in. You are advised to choose up to four schools, so please decide on this information beforehand.

PROBLEMS WITH THE BUS SERVICE?

A number of parents from the Symonds Green area tell us they often have problems with the bus service from there, which is having an effect on their child's attendance.
