WISEPAY

VOICEMAILS FROM SCHOOL

We often phone parents on their mobile and, when we cannot get through, leave a voicemail giving the reason for our call.

If you notice you have missed a call from the school, please check your voicemail *before* phoning us back. It may be that the message left is sufficient, and you do not need to return the call.

If we have asked you to call us back, the name of the person calling you will usually have been left in the message – we can then quickly put you through to that person, rather than putting you on hold whilst we try to find out who has called you. Thank you for your help with this.

If any parents have borrowed books from Sara Hassell, our Family Lives worker, please could we ask that you return them to school by the end of term. Thank you.

IS YOUR CHILD STARTING NURSERY SCHOOL IN SEPTEMBER 2016?

If your child was born between 1st September 2012 and 31st August 2013 you can now apply for a nursery place for the school year 2016-17.

The quickest and easiest way to apply is on-line at www.hertsdirect/admissions - application deadline TODAY 18th March 2016.

HOLIDAY IN TERM TIME

Just are reminder to parents/carers that the **school does not authorise holiday during term time,** except in very exceptional circumstances.

It is a parent's legal responsibility to ensure their child is in school. Ongoing unauthorised absence could lead to a Penalty Notice being issued to **each parent who has parental responsibility** for that child, which is a fine of £60 if paid within the first 21 days and £120 if paid after 21 days, but within 28 days of receipt of the notice. If the fine is not paid within 28 days parents could be prosecuted for their child's poor attendance.

Therefore, if you request holiday during term time, each parent we have on record as having parental responsibility for that child will receive an individual response to the request, along with any further correspondence relating their child's absence.
