IMPORTANT NOTICE!

Last year, our absence figures were very high – in total **our children missed 7.7% of possible sessions**, which is **way above the national target of 5.9%.** This is incredibly high and we need to work together as a school this year to improve things.

Some of this absence was, of course, totally unavoidable. However, a significant amount was due to holidays being taken in term time and odd days of absence.

I am sure you know already that the school strongly discourages children taking holidays during term time and I would like to remind you that this has a seriously negative effect on your child's learning.

However, having analysed absence so far this year, it is interesting that much of the absence is coming from children having **one or two days off for sickness here & there**. So far this term, 47 pupils have had a total of 53 odd days' absence. To help turn things around, I would ask that **if a child is feeling a bit under the weather due to a common cold or cough, PLEASE SEND THEM IN!** We will look after them and send them home if they get much worse. So often, a child will feel a bit rough in the morning but will perk up within a couple of hours and be much better off at school with all the distractions of the busy day. If you aren't sure, please feel free to ring the school office who will help you decide what to do based on your child's symptoms.
