MEDICAL MATTERS


There are lots of coughs and colds going around school at the moment, however, please can I ask parents not to send children to school with nasal sticks – thank you.

DEVELOPING SPECIAL PROVISION LOCALLY

Herts County Council are planning a project to develop and enhance the special educational provision for all of our special needs children and young people. The focus is on creating high quality, cost effective services in special and mainstream schools that enable children to have their needs met as locally as possible.

To do this they need to know what would make a difference to parents. They are, therefore, carrying out a pre-consultation, so that parents can give them their views and tell them what they think should be included in the formal consultation next year.
