It has been brought to our attention that a number of our pupils have set up accounts on a variety of social networking and chat sites, including Facebook, Bebo, Twitter, MySpace and msn. As I am sure you are aware, the minimum age required to set up a 'Facebook' account is **13** and in accordance with the stance we take within school about e-safety, I would ask you to consider carefully whether it is appropriate for our pupils to be engaging with platforms designed for teenagers and adults. The use of such sites is something you need to discuss with your children at the appropriate age – including the dangers of inappropriate befriending of strangers and cyberbullying.

In particular, I would urge you to find out if your children are using Facebook and, if they are, think about whether it is appropriate. At the very least, you should ensure their privacy settings are set at a safe level. If you have any concerns related to e-safety, I would be more than willing to discuss these with you.

In the meantime, I hope you have an enjoyable Easter break and look forward to seeing you all back at school at **8.50am** on **Tuesday**, **20**th **April**.
