#### **SCHOOL MEALS REMINDER**

This academic year, we made some important changes to the way in which we collect dinner money. May I remind parents/carers of the following:

- All dinners must be paid for up front. If the dinner has not been paid for, we will not be able to give your child a school meal that day.
- We ask that you pay in advance, by Monday morning, for all dinners that your child will have that week.
- We ask that you use Wisepay where possible, as this is easier for us to manage than cash payments. Please contact the school office if you have mislaid or need us to issue you with Wisepay log in details.

#### **PACKED LUNCHES**

If your child brings their own packed lunch to school, please could we ask that you do not include nuts or nut products (including peanut butter), as some of our children have nut allergies. Thank you for your support with this matter.

#### SCHOOL MILK FOR THE SUMMER TERM

Nursery milk is free to all nursery children and for any child who is in reception class and is 4 for the whole of the term, as this is Government funded. All children in Reception to Year 2 who are eligible for free meals will also get free milk.

If you wish your child to receive milk every day the charge for the summer term is £11.70. This must be paid for in advance, as only the number paid for will be ordered. Orders must be received by **Friday 22nd March 2013**. Please contact the office for further details.
