

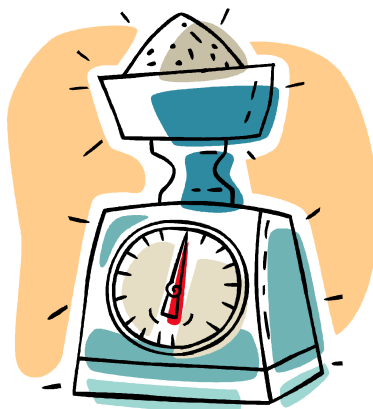

- ☐ Weigh food with your child and talk about foodstuffs using terms such as 'heavier' and 'lighter'
- ☐ If you are ordering a take-away get your child involved in selecting dishes and looking through the menu
