SCIENCE

Helping Plants Grow Well

The children will learn what plants need to grow well and why it is important that they do.

Rocks and Soils

The children will learn how soil is made and about the characteristics of different sorts of rock.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

We will be learning about 'Living Right' and 'Rights and Respect'.

INFORMATION AND COMMUNICATION TECHNOLOGY (ICT)

The children will learn how to combine text and graphics so that they complement each other. They will also explore and develop how to use the features of a word processor to match their work to their audience.

HISTORY

We will be learning about the effects of the invasion and settlement of the Romans in Britain.
