Year 2 – Sex and Relationships Education (SRE)

During the spring and summer terms of Year 2, the children will be covering aspects of their Sex and Relationships Education.

Sex and Relationships Education is part of the curriculum from Year 1 to Year 6. Throughout the school, children are encouraged to develop the self-esteem and confidence that they need to respond safely and responsibly to situations as they arise, both while they are at school and in the future.

The lessons comprise of watching age-appropriate television programmes which address the main issues. The programme will then be followed up by activities and discussion, led by the class teachers.

The following is a summary of the areas that will be taught in SRE in Year 2 this term. Please be reassured that these topics will be dealt with appropriately for the age of the children.
