#### **SCHOOL MEAL PRICES**

Just a reminder that, if you wish, school will provide children in **Reception to Year 2** with a nutritious **school meal for FREE**. These are called Universal Free School Meals.

If, however, you are claiming certain benefits and are, therefore, eligible to apply for Free School Meal status, please contact the school office and we can help you apply. The school will receive funding for each child registered, which will be used to give them extra support in school.

For those children in Years 3 – 6 the price of school meals for this year is as follows:

£2.30 per day / £11.50 per week

Nursery Lunch Club: £4.70 per day (£2.50 for home packed lunch and those entitled to FSM).
