RETURN TO TEACHING COURSES

Herts for Learning understand that a key priority for many schools is identifying and securing high quality teaching staff. As a result, we have developed a range of support to help our schools, including the new Teach in Herts website, reduced fees from agencies, marketing materials for schools.

We are also keen to provide support to teachers considering returning to the profession after a career break. Returning to the classroom can be quite daunting if you have been out of school for a while. Our Confident to Return programme comprises of four half-day training sessions, each focussed on updating qualified teachers on a different aspect of the current curriculum. The programme also provides:

- an overview to recent changes
- practical guidance about the new expectations in schools
- latest guidance
- assessment and planning support
- · current teaching styles
- units of work
- A support network of returning teachers

The programme offers an ideal platform from which to develop a support network to help you return, including professional support from school advisers and other returning teachers.

The cost of attending the programme is $\pounds 250$, however $\pounds 125$ will be refunded to individuals who are offered and accept a teaching job in a Hertfordshire school within six months of completing the course.
