We have heard lots about you from your year 2 teachers and are very excited to be welcoming you into Hornbeam in September.






## All About Me: Mrs Marlow

I always wanted to be a teacher, even as a little girl, and have been teaching for 24 years!!


• I have been married for 14 years and we have three children: Alfie (13), Finley (11) and Mollie (8)

• I am proud to say that I have supported Liverpool FC since I was 6 years old!




• My favorite subjects when I was at school were English and History.

And her favourite colour is blue.






