During this second half term of Year 1, your child will be studying subjects under the theme of Seasons

They will be taking part in a series of exciting activities, which include:

- Looking at weather patterns in the UK and around the world
- Observing changes across the four seasons.
- Finding out about different trees Deciduous and Evergreen
- Finding out about nocturnal animals and hibernation
- Finding out about the North and South pole
- Experiments with ice and rainfall
- Looking at the book; Hurricane by David Wiesner in our Take One Book sessions.

- Measure rainfall with your child
 - Go to the library and find books about the weather and seasons
 - Explore different parts of the world and their weather including hot and cold parts of the world
 - Look at the North and South pole on Google Earth
 - Discuss with your child the changes in the environment during each season
 - Go on a nature walk and talk about what you can see
- Research some of the words in the glossary box
- Support with a research project on seasons (information will be sent out in the first homework flyer)
