### What are we learning about this term?

### **ENGLISH**

- Narrative Poetry
- Narrative Reading/Writing of traditional stories, fables, myths and legends
- Writing a recount
- The structure and organisation of writing
- Complex Sentences
- Reading fluently and with expression

#### **MATHEMATICS**

- Written Methods for addition and subtraction
- Application to real life problems

### **SCIENCE**

### Gases around Us

In this unit children learn that gases are material and can be distinguished from solids and liquids by their properties.

### **Changing Sound**

In this unit children learn that sounds are produced by vibrations and that these vibrations travel from the source through a variety of materials.

### **RELIGIOUS EDUCATION**

### **Justice**

This unit explores ideas of fairness and justice in Christianity, Islam and Judaism. Pupils will have opportunities to consider their own views on fairness, forgiveness and justice, and express how those views affect the way they choose to live their lives.

### **INFORMATION AND COMMUNICATION TECHNOLOGY (ICT)**

This term pupils will be learning how to use PowerPoint to combine images, text, sound and movement.

### **GEOGRAPHY**

### Water

In this unit children learn about water supply around the world. They learn about the importance of clean water and investigate how it is supplied. They also consider who owns and manages water, and contrast water use at home with use in less economically developed countries.

# ART AND DESIGN DESIGN AND TECHNOLOGY

### **Talking Textiles**

Children explore how stories have been represented in textiles in different times and cultures. They work together to make a two- or three-dimensional work based on a familiar story, myth or legend. They investigate and use a range of materials, techniques and textile processes to create surface patterns and textures and other visual and sound effects.

### Musical Instruments

Children learn about the construction of a range of musical instruments, including those from different times and cultures, and how different sounds can be created and altered to make different notes. They learn to use this knowledge and understanding to design and make a working musical instrument using a combination of materials.

### **Invasion Games**

Children will learn the skills of attack and defence in various different invasion games.

### **Swimming**

Swimming lessons will continue to run weekly.

Children will be exploring creative dance and developing control of their movement and gestures.
