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# CURRICULUM INFORMATION



Key Stage Two Year 5 Summer Term 2009

## What are we learning about this term?

#### **ENGLISH**

- Traditional stories, fables, myths and legends
- Film Narrative
- Instructions
- The structure and organisation of writing
- Complex Sentences
- Reading fluently and with expression

#### **MATHEMATICS**

- Written Methods for addition and subtraction
- Application to real life problems
- Understanding shape and space
- Data handling
- Measuring capacity, volume and length
- Securing number facts, e.g. times-tables and number bonds

#### **SCIENCE**

<u>Keeping Healthy</u> - Pupils learn about the heart and how heart beat is affected by exercise and relate this to what they already know about movement and exercise.

<u>Life Cycles</u> -Pupils learn that plants and animals reproduce as part of their life cycle and that in every life cycle there are distinct processes and stages.

#### **RELIGIOUS EDUCATION**

Justice - Pupils will continue to explore Christianity and Islam.

#### **INFORMATION AND COMMUNICATION TECHNOLOGY (ICT)**

<u>Control and Monitoring</u> – Pupils learn how to use input devices or switches to control a process.

#### **HISTORY**

Who were the Ancient Greeks? -Pupils find out about the way people lived in the ancient Greek empire and about the influence the ancient Greeks continue to have on our lives.

#### **GEOGRAPHY**

None this term

#### **MUSIC**

Pupils will develop and demonstrate their ability to take part in a class performance with confidence, expression and control.
