If someone is unkind to us online or makes us feel uncomfortable should we tell an adult? 92% 8% Yes: No: 5. Should we ever meet someone we met online even if they are our friend? 35% 65% Yes: No:

Although these results show that generally the e-safety message it getting through I feel it still highlights the necessity of further work to be completed to ensure children are safe while online. Please see the letter also going out today about how to keep your child safe online.
