Re: E Safety Week Questionnaire Results KS2

Last week as part of e-safety week all children in school on Monday 7th February completed a questionnaire about e-safety. I would like to share the results of this with you:

1.) How often do you use the internet?

Everyday: 48% More than once a week: 25% Once a week: 16% Once a month: 2%

Less than once a month: 9%

2.) If you use it every day how many hours do you use it for? Choose one

Less than 1: 17% 1-2: 37% 2-3: 23% 3-4: 13% 4+: 10%

3.) How often do you use....

a.) Chat rooms? Choose one

Everyday: 18% More than once a week: 14% Once a week: 25% Once a month: 7%

Less than once a month: 36%

b.) Instant Messenger? Choose one

Everyday: 11% More than once a week: 9% Once a week: 11% Once a month: 17%

Less than once a month: 52%

c.) Social Networking sites? Choose one

Everyday: 27% More than once a week: 11% Once a week: 7% Once a month: 9%

Less than once a month: 45%

4.) Where do you use the internet most? Choose one

Home: 84% School: 5% Mobile Phone: 9% Other: 2%

5.) If you use internet at home what room do you use it in? Choose one

Living Room: 36% Bedroom: 39% Dining Room: 9% Other: 16%

6.) How many online contacts do you have that you have not met in the real world?

None: 64% 1-10: 17% 11-25: 11% 26-50: 7% 50-100: 5% 100-200: 0%

7.) Have you ever met someone in the real world you have only met online?

Yes: 40% No: 60%

8.) If you answered 'yes' to Q9 did you take someone with you: Yes: 50% No: 50%

9.) Do you use a webcam?

Yes: 39% No: 61%

10.) Has anyone ever been unkind to you over the internet or your mobile phone?

Yes: 34% No: 66%

Although these results show that generally the e-safety message it getting through I feel it still highlights the necessity for further work to be completed to ensure children are safe while online. Please see the letter also going out today about how to keep your child safe online. Working with your child to ensure they know how to keep themselves safe would be beneficial.
